

# RYHB Meeting Minutes ~ June 10th, 2008

**Secretary's Report:** May minutes presented. Lynn Sweetman motioned to approve with changes (April vs. May Treasurer's Report), Kerri DuPuis 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Approved.

## Old Business

1. Roadside Clean-Up: Held May 17<sup>th</sup>. We had a small turnout; next year we need to find a way to get more people involved.
2. Giving Back: Popcorn Maker- After comparing the available models (including the Red Pine Popcorn Maker), warranties, service agreements, and price, it was decided that the Whiz Bang model for \$1295 was the best choice. Susan Carter motioned to approve, Lynn Sweetman 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Approved.
3. Booster Banner: The Booster Banner was taken down while the ceiling was being repainted. The arena is not yet ready to re-hang the banner.
4. Assistant Tournament Director: There has not been any interest; position will stay posted.

## New Business

1. Board Update: Dallen Schnichels is fundraising coordinator. Enjoy has donated 1000 hot dogs. They are considering a dream vacation raffle with a \$7000 value, limit ticket sales to 1000 @ \$20 each. Pull tabs are a declining business; most places contract March to March. Enjoy has agreed to do a breakfast fundraiser, \$6 in advance, \$7 at the door, profit of \$4/person. They provide the chef, we serve. How many tickets could we sell? Hockey Day in Rosemount: 10/25/08. The Board is talking about having hockey games for all travelling teams, a Halloween party, and a bowling event. Taste of Rosemount: have local restaurants do food samples, charge \$20 to \$25 per person. Wine tasting party at Enjoy: \$40/couple in advance, \$50 at the door.
2. Leprechaun Days Parade: Kelly Sabo put in a request for our parade spot, as well as a booth at the Midsummer Faire. July 26<sup>th</sup> parade, July 25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>th</sup> for the booth. Cost of freeze pops went up from \$4.98 last year to \$8.68 this year. Susan recommends putting the word out to the Boosters asking for volunteers to freeze the pops and bring them to the arena freezer. Arena freezer needs to be turned on the day before we need it to get it cold. Volunteers can call the arena to get in and put the freeze pops in the freezer.
3. Fundraising- let's wait to do the Hockey Mom's Expo. It might be too much with Hockey Day in Rosemount.
4. Merchandise sales: Terry LaMere from Westwood will be at the next meeting.
5. Website info: Booster FAQ's have been posted. The merchandise page has not yet been updated. We will start posting our meeting minutes.
6. Team Banners: only two were turned in after last season, and both were in rough shape. Do we have volunteers willing to make new ones that could easily be changed yearly for new teams?
